Origin

Bordeaux. Wine from Château Pilet. Grape production, winemaking and ageing take place on the family estate.

Special features

The Merlot, the Cabernet Sauvignon and the Cabernet Franc belong to the traditional varieties of The Bordeaux wine region.

The Merlot brings colour, roundness and fruitiness to wine whereas the Cabernets give softness and a wealth of gentle tannins. The subtle blend of those three varieties, harvested at optimum ripeness, gives birth to an aromatic, rich and pleasant wine with remarkable ageing potential.

Serve

The wine should be served at room temperature between 18 and 20 °C. This red wine is to be appreciated during the meal and is an ideal accompaniment to red meats and cheeses. The wine will benefit from a little ageing but can be drunk now.

Tasting

Dressed with a beautiful garnet colour and a deep brilliance. The powerful nose who gives a bouquet of red fruits crisp, we can easily find aromas of blackcurrant and blackberry complemented by spicy notes. The mouth follows the same aromatic line , round, generous, ample and balanced, range of savoury tannins promising a bright future.
